PHC 2009 Staff Vaccination Campaign

Objection of survey:

- Identify perceptions around the flu shot to determine why staff do or do not get a flu shot.
- Evaluate the effectiveness of communicating flu shot information to staff at PHC during the fall 2009 staff flu campaign.

Target audience:

- Staff at all sites across PHC eligible to receive a flu shot.

Survey questions:

1. What is your job title?
